Montgomery Art Association's, "Paint the Town" Labor Day Weekend Art Show

has been a major art event in Kensington, Maryland for fifteen years. We'd like to invite you to participate in this well-attended exhibition. The show attracts thousands of visitors and, for those interested, sells thousands of dollars worth of art works . *There are two stipulations in order to participate in this show:*

1. At least one of the pieces must reflect or be representative of the Town of Kensington. The work does not have representational. Your representation of the town may be in the artistic style of your choice. Paintings and sculptors are both welcome.
2. All artists are asked to assist with the show in some capacity. All participating MAA members MUST volunteer. This may be accomplished in many ways: assisting with the reception, publicity, soliciting donations, hanging flyers, cashiering, greeting guests, setting up and hanging. . .

This is a judged show. The judge is award winning artist and Montgomery College Art Professor, Michael Sastre. All artwork will be accepted into the show. Award winners will receive cash and/or prizes.

Making the application available at this early date allows participant artists, who have not already done so, ample time to visit Kensington and get a feel for the community that will be depicted in the required artwork. Entrants should use the "Paint the Town" attached application. The applications are due by August 25, 2009.

Additional 'Paint the Town' Plein Air Event:

In addition to the Kensington Armory exhibition, there is also a Plein Air Event that will take place on Saturday, September 5, 2009 from daybreak to 3:00 PM. This event is free for members of MAA and \$5.00 for non-members. You do not need to participate in the general show in order to participate in the Plein Air Event. It will be judged by Ruth Ellsworth and Julie O'Malley at 3:00 PM , Saturday, September 5, 2009. These paintings will then be on exhibit with the rest of the show and can be offered for sale, if the artists wishes to do so.
