### Plein Air Olney 2009 August 31- October 24, 2009

Sponsored by the Olney Farmers and Artist Market

The purpose of Plein Air Olney 2009 is to raise awareness in the community about the wonderful natural features, historic sites, museums, and merchants found in Olney and the surrounding area and to celebrate the strong artist community by sharing an open air painting and drawing event. The posted deadline is Aug. 28 but we have been assured by the organizers that our members are not to worry since they are extending the deadline for students (and others), as they will not get the information until after the 31st. Also additional entries are allowed on the PAINT/DRAW days during a morning check in on each day of the painting/drawing weekends.

### Free Workshops on August 30, September 6, 13, 20

Prior to the event there are workshops being held at the Market from 10 am to 1 pm being conducted by Tara Hall and Roberta Staat. Plein air techniques will be demonstrated. These are not mandatory but a good way to have some fun and learn stuff as well.

### Paint/Draw Days for Plein Air Olney 2009

There are many picturesque sites in and around Olney, Ashton, Brookeville, Laytonsville, Brinklow, Sunshine, Highland, and nearby. In general there are a lot of rural sites when you move out of the town centers. There are several historic homes, churches, and public buildings that may be interesting to draw or paint. You may find more contemporary merchant facades or businesses will have appeal. There are two days (9/27 & 10/4) when the Farmers & Artists Market is going on from 9am – 1 pm, so you might find drawing/painting the vendors, flowers, vegetables, people, musicians, etc. will be great fun! You may create your works at other locations but the organizers want to know where you will be "working" at PAINT/DRAW DAYS REGISTRATION. Each artist will be asked to post an "ARTIST AT WORK" sign wherever they work for the day. At registration there will be a list of site possibilities.

Saturdays 9/26 & 10/3 check in sites will be at al Sospiro Roman Trattoria & Wine Bar parking lot – there will be a Plein Air Olney 2009 tent set up. Al Sospiro Trattoria is located one block south of Georgia Ave. (Rt. 97) and Route 108 (Olney Laytonsville Rd) at 18035 Georgia Ave. in Olney. The Saturday check in tents will be set up from 8am – 11 am.

Sunday 9/27 & 10/4 check in sites will be at the Olney Farmers & Artists Market at the shopping center 1 block east of the intersection of Route 108 & Georgia Ave. on Route 108 in Olney.

Look for the Plein Air Olney 2009 tent. The Sunday check in tents will be set up during the Market opening hours of 9am – 1pm and will stay until at least 2:00 pm (1 hour after Market officially closes) on the last paint/draw day, October 4th.

On October 11 all work to be exhibited must be framed/matted and dropped off at the Olney Farmers & Artists Market by 1 pm and these collected works will be displayed at area merchants. Locations will be listed on the market website and People's Choice votes will be cast. This display runs until the 17th.

From October 19-24 all framed/matted work moves to be exhibited at the Sandy Spring Museum and on the 24th an evening gala/auction will be held at the Sandy Spring museum. October 25th will be the pick up date for all remain words. All are welcome to participate: professional and amateur alike and there are special children's categories

Minimum size of work is 12" x 12" maximum size 24" x 36"

One entry is \$7, Two entries \$14, Three entries \$15, Additional entries are \$5 each

- All work is to be done on site, no photographs will be permitted, no additional work can be done in the studio
- All artists must make one piece of work available for auction 20% of sales are to be donated to the Olney Farmers & Artists Market
- All artists are highly encourage to attend the Gala Event on October 24th at the Sandy spring museum to meet their patrons and receive awards
