at Daily Dish, Silver Spring, MD

MAA is looking forward to this Abstracts show at the popular Daily Dish restaurant in Silver Spring. The restaurant is open Monday thru Thursday, 11:30am to 9pm, Fridays 11:30am to 9:30pm, Saturdays 10am to 9:30pm and Sundays 10am to 9pm. Plans for a reception are underway.

Show dates: May 1 – June 30, 2022

Location: The Daily Dish, 8301 Grubb Rd, Silver Spring, MD 20910

Media eligible for exhibition: Artwork for this exhibit should be two-dimensional works in oil, acrylic, watercolor, mixed media, pastel, encaustic, drawing/ink or photography. 3D works are not accepted. All works must be 36"x36" or smaller (framed).

Subject: Abstract

Number of pieces allowed: Each member may submit 1 entry.

Registration dates: Registration starts Saturday, April 2, 2022. It ends Tuesday, April 12, 2022, at 11:59 pm ET, or earlier, if show capacity is reached.

Entry fee: \$10 (nonrefundable)

Reception: Plans are underway for a reception to celebrate the show. Details will be shared via email and social media.

How to Register

Go to <https://montgomeryart.org/event-4686686>. Log in with your email address and password. You will be asked for:

- Artwork title using title case (example: River View)
- Media
- Price
- Optional: 1 image of your artwork (to be used for show promotional purposes)
- Volunteering role

Requirements

Entries: Entries submitted must be original work of the artist. The hand of the artist must be visible and dominant in constructing fine art works. Digitally manipulated images are not acceptable unless they are used in a secondary manner to the artwork as a whole and clearly described in the media description.

Key Dates:

Registration: April 2- 12 (or once the maximum capacity of 15 pieces is reached)

Drop off: May 1, 8am – 9am

Hanging: May 1, 8:30 am – 10am

Show Dates: May 1 – June 30, 2022

Reception: Date TBD

Pick up unsold works: June 30, 8am – 11am.

Dates subject to change; you'll be kept informed via email.

MAA or The Daily Dish reserves the right to refuse to display any artwork it deems incompatible with the nature and environment of The Daily Dish.

Wall-hung works: Wall-hung works must be no larger than 36"x36" framed. Weight limit is 50 pounds. All works must be framed and wired for hanging to professional standards. Use D-rings and weight-appropriate wire that is not visible when the painting is hung. Paintings on canvas do not require frames if the edges are painted or taped to professional standards. No wet canvases, saw-toothed hangers, or flimsy framing. [Learn more.](#)

Label: Affix a label to the back of your work with your name, phone number, and title.

Sales: Entries must be priced and available for sale for the duration of the show, May 1 – June 30. Sold works must remain until the end of the show. Buyers must pick up the art on the pickup day (or the artist can pick up on behalf of the buyer and arrange for delivery).

Drop-off: Drop off is Sunday, May 1, 8 am-9 am. The early hour will allow us to hang the show before the restaurant opens. If you're unable to drop off at that time, we suggest posting a message on our [private Facebook group](#) to see if a fellow participant could drop off for you.

Pick up: Unsold works should be picked up on Thursday, June 30, 8 to 11am. again, before the restaurant opens for the day. If you're unable to pick up at this time, we suggest you post a message on our [private Facebook group](#) to see if a fellow participant could pick up for you.

Volunteering: As we are an all-volunteer organization, we rely on our members to assist us in producing our shows. All members should volunteer for at least 1-2 shows per year. For this show, we are seeking volunteers to assist with the following. Indicate on your registration form if you are available for:

- **Check in:** We are seeking 2-3 members to check in participating artists. You'll come to the restaurant on Sunday, May 1 from 8:00 am to 10am. Duties include checking the registration list; ensuring pieces are wired, framed and labeled correctly, and directing members on where to place their checked-in work.
- **Hanging the show:** We're looking for 2 - 3 members to work together to curate and hang the works in the gallery. You will need to arrange the works in a pleasing design and hang them along with their labels. This task will also be done on Sunday, May 1 from 8:30am to 10am. Volunteers, therefore, could both check in and hang work.
- **Publicity:** 2-4 members are needed to assist with promoting our show. Tasks could include drafting a news release, submitting the show to local calendar websites and media outlets, writing blog posts or making videos about the show. (Each volunteer would be given just one of these tasks.)
- **Reception:** We will host a reception; we don't have details yet, but please indicate on the registration form if you'd like to learn more and potentially help.
- **Pickup:** 1-2 members to oversee pickup of artwork on Thursday, June 30, from 8am to 10am.
