July 2019 MAA Show at Ranazul Restaurant

Show dates: July 7 – August 4, 2019

Show location: Ranazul Restaurant Banquet Room, 8171 Maple Lawn Blvd #170, Fulton, MD

Media eligible for exhibition: 2D work, including oil, acrylic, watercolor, mixed media, pastel, pencil, encaustic, drawing/ink mediums. 3D work and photography are not included in this exhibit.

Number of pieces allowed: Members may submit one entry. Maximum size (including frame) is 24" wide x 24" tall, including the frame.

Registration Fee: \$10

Registration: June 1 – 10, 2019

Note: The exhibit space holds about 25 wall-hung art. If the number of entries reaches the gallery capacity prior to the deadline, registration will be closed.

Entries submitted must be original work of the artist. The hand of the artist must be visible and dominant in constructing the artwork. MAA or Ranazul Restaurant reserves the right to refuse to display any artwork it deems incompatible with the nature and environment of the Ranazul Restaurant. No nudes, please.

How to register: We only accept [online registration](#) on our website. Included:

- **Title of artwork:** Please use title case, capitalizing the first letter of significant words in the titles of your piece. (Example: *Still Life with Pears.*)
- **Media** Please select one of the standard options or select "Other" and describe.
- **Dimensions:** Enter the Width x Length dimensions
- **Price:** Use a dollar sign and numerals, no cents. (Example: \$175)

- **Images:** Images of your artwork are encouraged but not required. By uploading images of your works, you agree to allow MAA to use those images for the purpose of promoting this event in digital and print materials.

Key Dates:

- **Start of Registration:** Saturday, June 1
- **Registration Deadline:** Monday, June 10
- **Drop off & Hang Artwork:** Sunday, July 7, 10am – noon
- **Reception:** Sunday, July 14th, 4 – 5pm
- **Pick Up Unsold Artwork:** Sunday, August 4, 10 – 11am

*By submitting an entry, registrants agree with the following:
I certify that I agree to the rules of the show as presented here. Entries submitted are my own work. I will not hold MAA or the Ranazul Restaurant responsible for any loss or damage to my artwork while on the property. MAA reserves the right to reject inappropriate or improperly framed work. Artists are advised to have their own insurance for their artworks.*

Show promotions: MAA will promote this show via its usual channels: Newsletter, Email, Facebook, and Instagram. Artists are encouraged to ‘share’ MAA promotions with their friends, family, and colleagues.

Sales: Ranazul Restaurant will manage all sales, including collecting and reporting sales tax. They will keep a 20% commission and send the artist a check at the end of August. Buyers will be able to take the art when they purchase it; artists are welcome to bring a replacement piece of art (need to coordinate replacement label).

Volunteer service is needed the day of drop off for hanging. Please plan to stay and assist with the hanging.

Reception: Ranazul Restaurant will host an opening Reception on Sunday, July 14 (exact time is tbd, late afternoon). They will provide delicious hors d’oerves. Please invite family and friends to attend. MAA will publicize this in our social media outlets.

Artwork Hanging:

Artwork is to have a label on the back (top right), securely attached. This includes:

- Artist Name & Email
- Title
- Medium
- Price

Works must be framed and wired for hanging to professional standards.

Use D-rings and weight-appropriate wire that is not visible when the painting is hung. (See below) Paintings on canvas do not require frames as long as the edges are painted or taped to professional standards. No wet canvases, saw-toothed hangers, or flimsy framing.

Care will be taken by MAA volunteers in hanging and securing the show. However, neither MAA nor Ranazul will be held responsible for any loss or damage. Artists should hold their own insurance to cover loss or damage for their individual artworks.
